

## **OA-INVOLVE Research Associate Department of Community Health & Epidemiology**

The Older Adults' Active Involvement in Aging and Technology Research and Development (OA-INVOLVE) project is funded by the AGE-WELL National Centre of Excellence. The aim of the project is to establish models of best practice for the active involvement of older adults in technology development projects to improve the independence, health, wellbeing and quality of life of older adults.

### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

This is a new position created to initiate the OA-INVOLVE research program and oversee all the research activities conducted throughout the project. Reporting to the Network Investigator, the Project Manager will coordinate with research teams in the AGE-WELL Network, interface with prospective stakeholders, and manage the work of the project in multiple locations across the country.

This position offers the opportunity to be involved in all aspects of the research project. The Project Manager will prepare Research Ethics Board (REB) applications, conduct interviews with study participants, perform data analysis, and develop evaluation strategies.

Dissemination of the project outcomes will include preparing manuscripts and conference presentations, as well as furthering the research through identifying funding opportunities and writing grant applications.

This dynamic position demands the ability to work independently as well as with a multidisciplinary research team. The successful candidate will be expected to develop partnerships with public and private agencies, including the lay public, volunteer and special interest groups.

### **Requirements:**

The ideal candidate will possess a doctorate, or have equivalent experience in health sciences, social sciences, and/or behavioural sciences. Consideration will be given to applicants with masters' level training and relevant work experience.
